## From the Editor

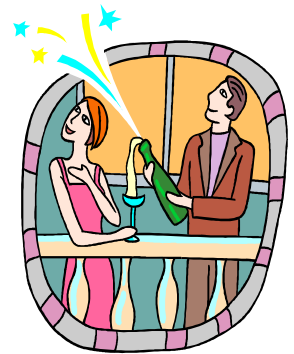

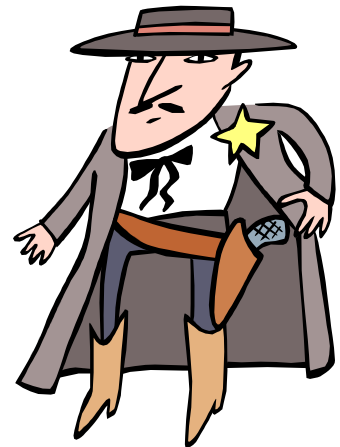
